



## Ohio Alliance Internships

The Ohio School-Based Health Alliance (“Ohio Alliance”) is a professional, nonpartisan, nonprofit<sup>1</sup> organization, serving as the only statewide organization created to advance and support the sustainability and expansion of school-based health care. The mission of the Ohio Alliance is to improve access to comprehensive, integrated health services through school-based health care to advance equity and improve health and education outcomes for students, their families, and communities.

The Ohio Alliance offers unpaid internship opportunities to undergraduate and graduate students who are interested in learning about school-based health care, healthcare administration, public health, health and education policy, and nonprofit operations – including administration, resource development and communications. Interns of the Ohio Alliance will gain an understanding of and familiarity with Ohio’s school-based health care system, including state and local-level school-based health care partners.

Interns can work on a variety of projects and initiatives at the Ohio Alliance including quantitative and qualitative data collection and analysis, literature review, developing policy briefs and factsheets, stakeholder engagement, partnership building, advocacy and communications. Interns will have the opportunity to interact with and work alongside the Ohio Alliance’s health and education state and local-level partners.

Typical unpaid internships with the Ohio Alliance are:

- The length of an academic semester (4-5 months)
- 10-20 hours per week
- Conducted in a remote work environment, with the opportunity to attend in-person and on-line meetings and events
- Combined with academic program requirements or elective credit
