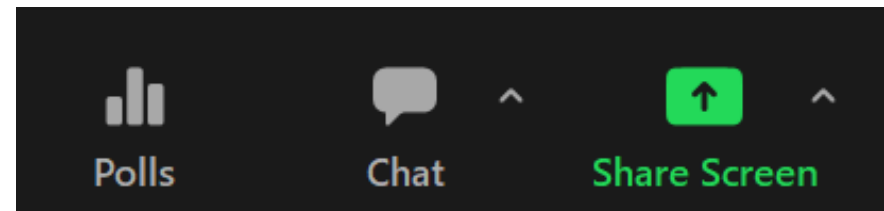
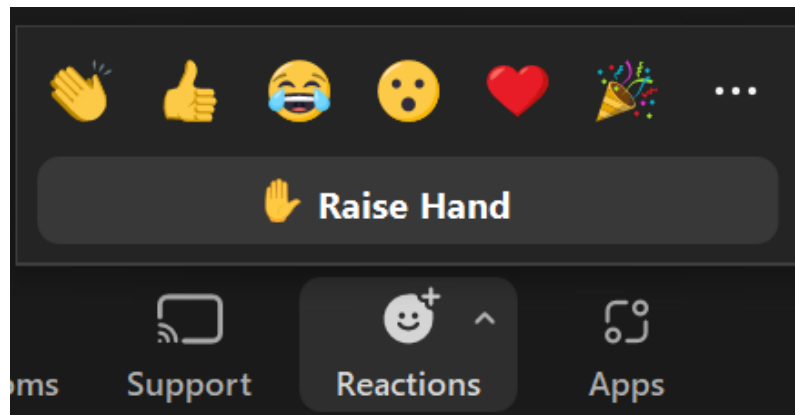

# Ohio landscape

**3% of Ohio youth** smoked all or part of a **cigarette in the last 30 days**

**8% of Ohio youth** have used an **electronic vapor product in the last 30 days**, and **17.5% of Ohio youth** have used an **electronic vapor product in their lifetime**

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# Ohio landscape

**18% of Ohio adults** smoke cigarettes, meaning Ohio ranks **44 out of 50** states and D.C. in adult smoking

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# Purpose of RFP: Project goals



Increased screening & identification of youth nicotine use



Increased referrals of youth to nicotine dependence treatment



Decreased prevalence of youth nicotine use



# Purpose of RFP

- **Fund four school-based health center sites** to *implement or strengthen* tobacco screening and referrals
- **\$34,000 per SBHC site** over the course of the project
  - Funding is deliverables-based



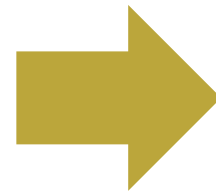
# Deliverables

Adopt, implement, and document a screening and referral workflow system change in SBHC to ensure all youth receiving at least one SBHC service are screened for tobacco and nicotine use

Submit baseline and monthly data

Participate in quarterly virtual learning community sessions

All clinical staff attend an “Act-Counsel-Treat” virtual training



Administer “Act-Counsel-Treat” training to at least 20 non-clinical school district staff

- Information about your SBHC, patient population, and community you serve
- Project lead
- Additional relevant information



# Section 2: Intervention Plan

- Describe your current tobacco/nicotine screening and referral process
- Describe how you propose to implement or strengthen a tobacco/nicotine screening and referral process
- Plan for how you will engage non-clinical school district staff in your efforts
- Identify the screening tool you plan to use



# Section 3: Challenges and Technical Assistance

- Identify any challenges you anticipate in implementing the screening/referral process, completing deliverables, and documenting metrics
- Include additional support or training that would help you be successful

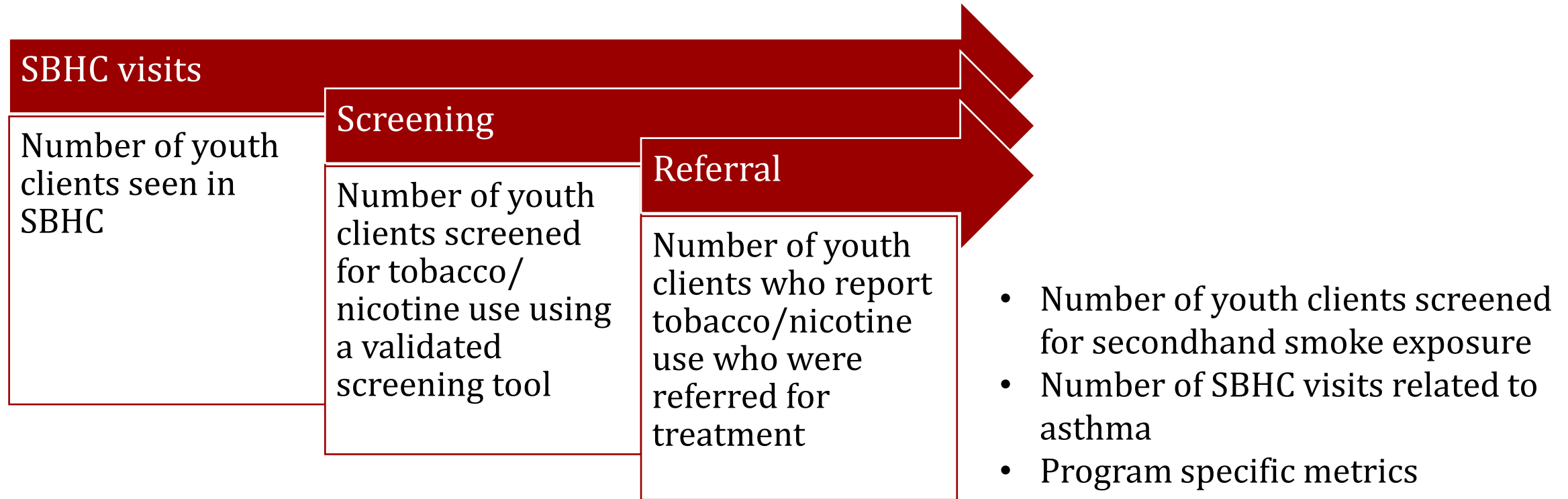


# Section 4: Evaluation Plan

- Describe your plan to document workflow changes, screening and referral processes, lessons learned, etc.
- For each metric, report:
  - Whether it's currently collected
  - Current process for documenting the metric, or proposed process for documenting the metric

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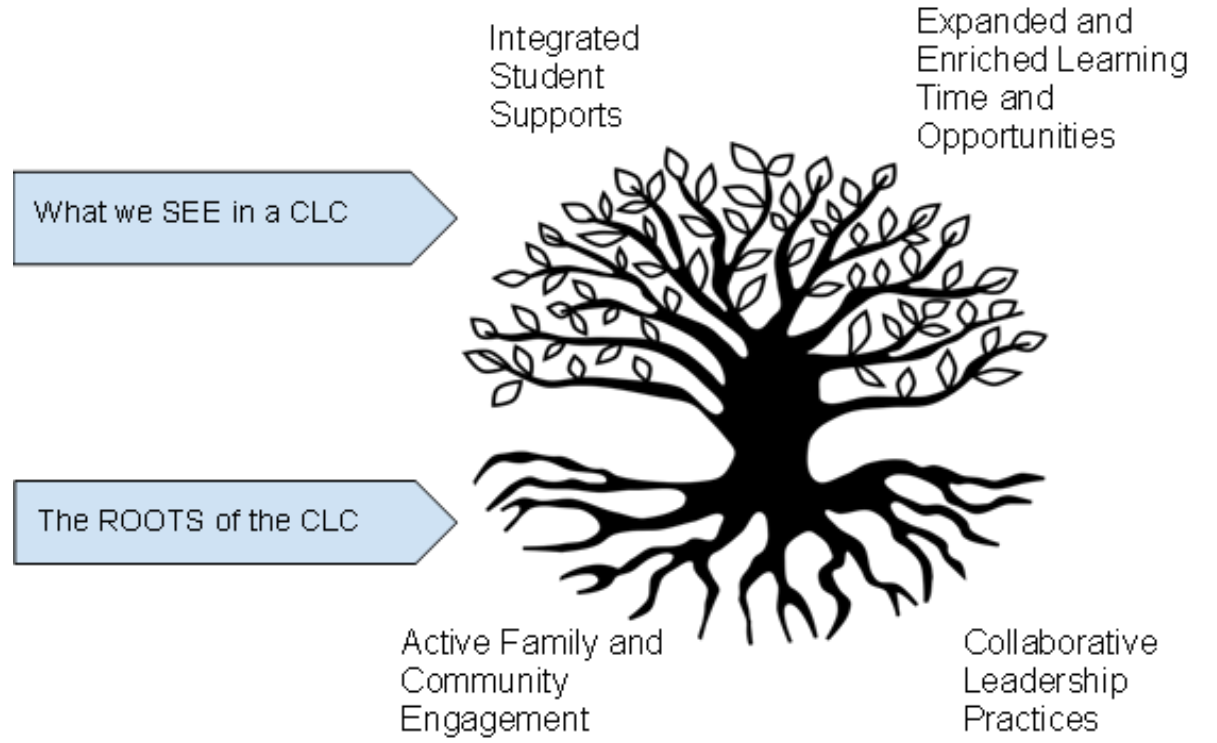
